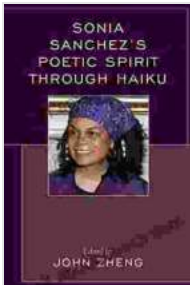

which provides writing workshops and mentorship programs for young writers.

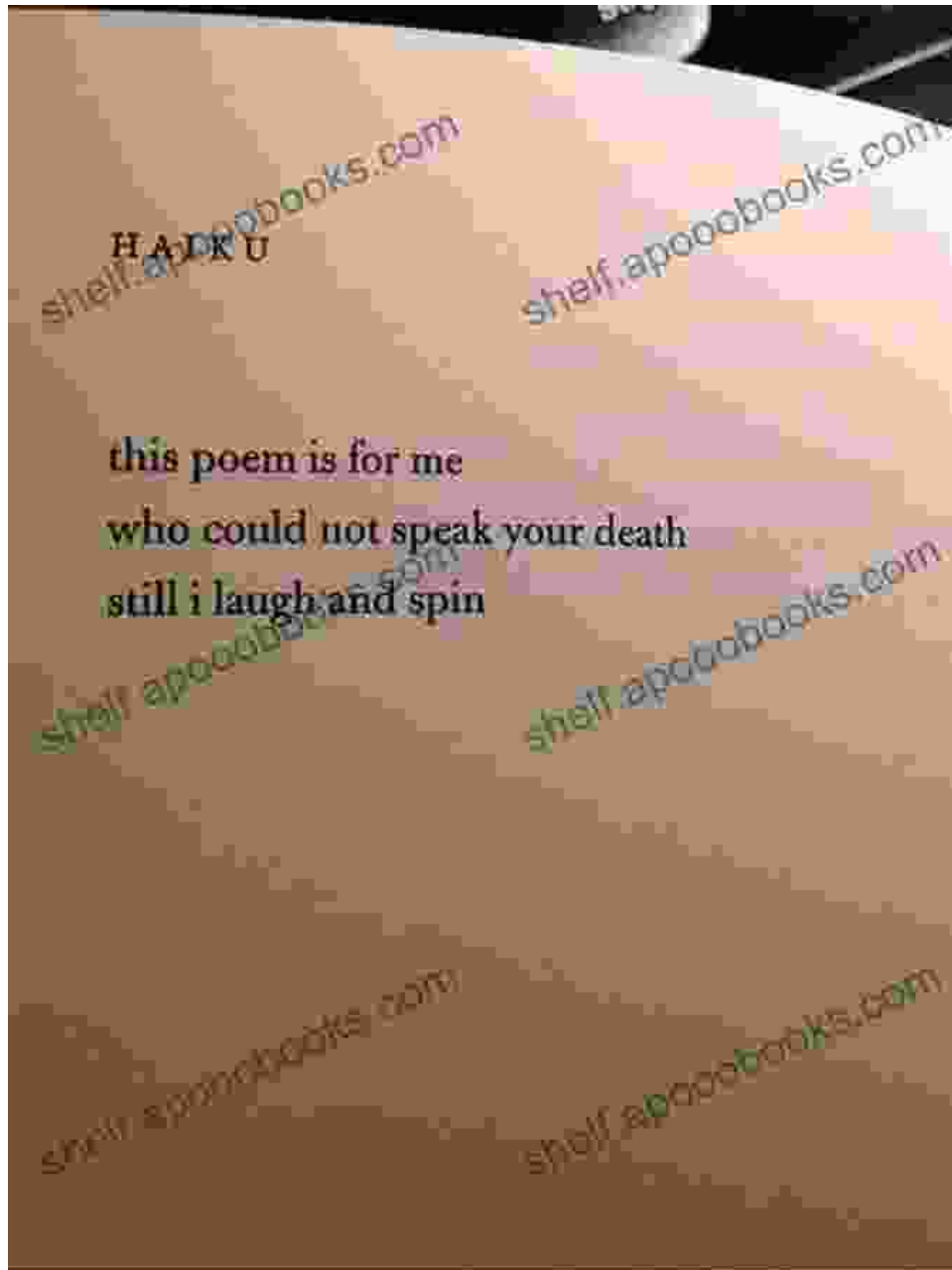
Sample Haiku

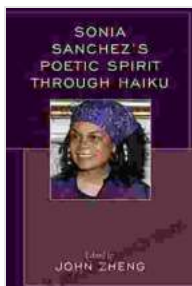

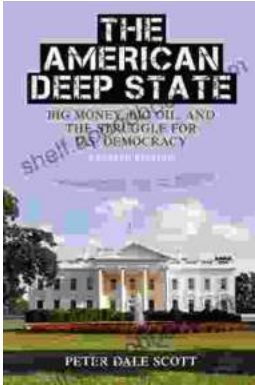

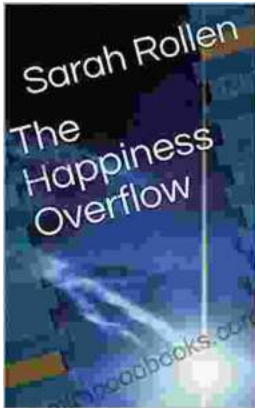
