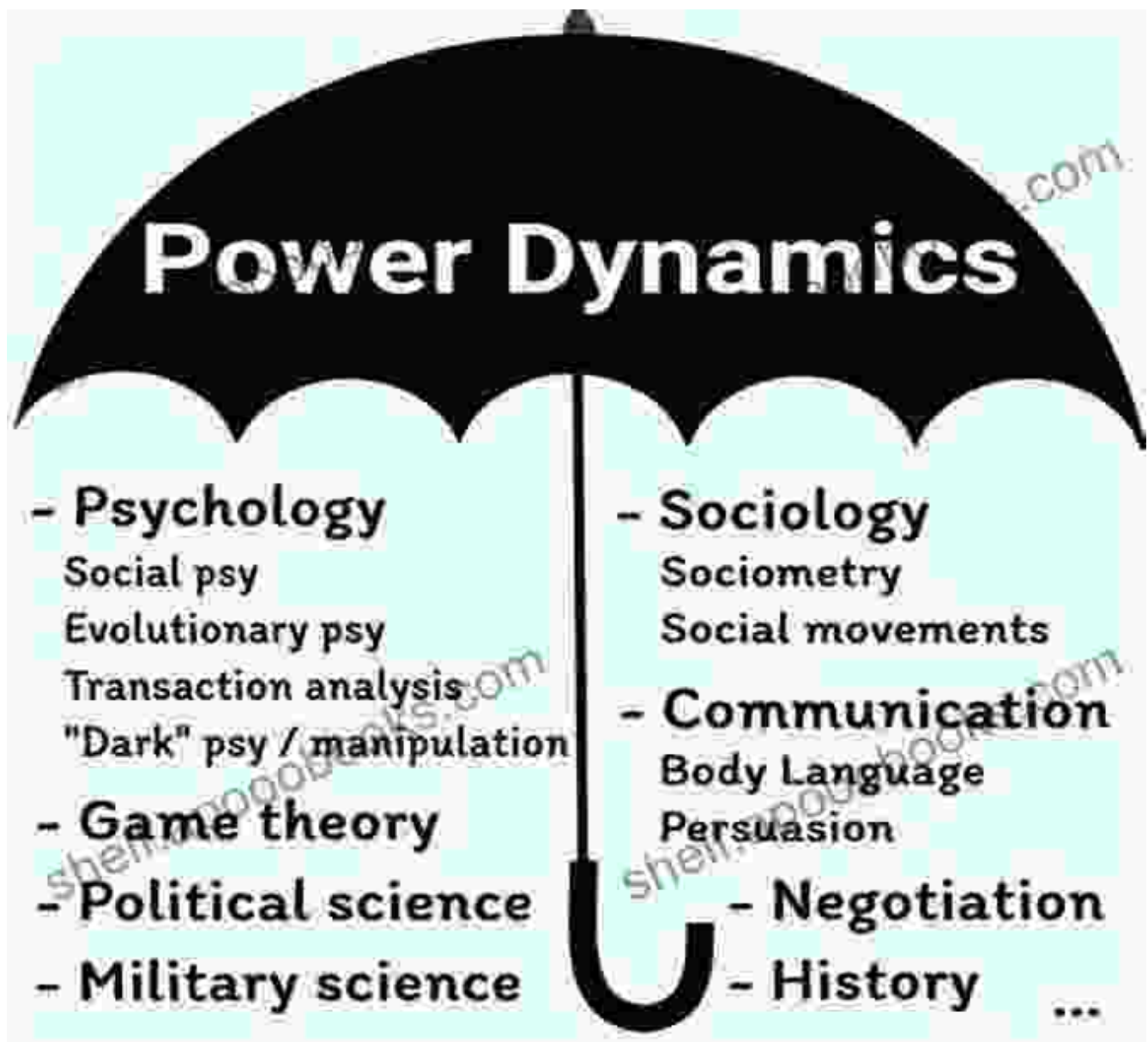

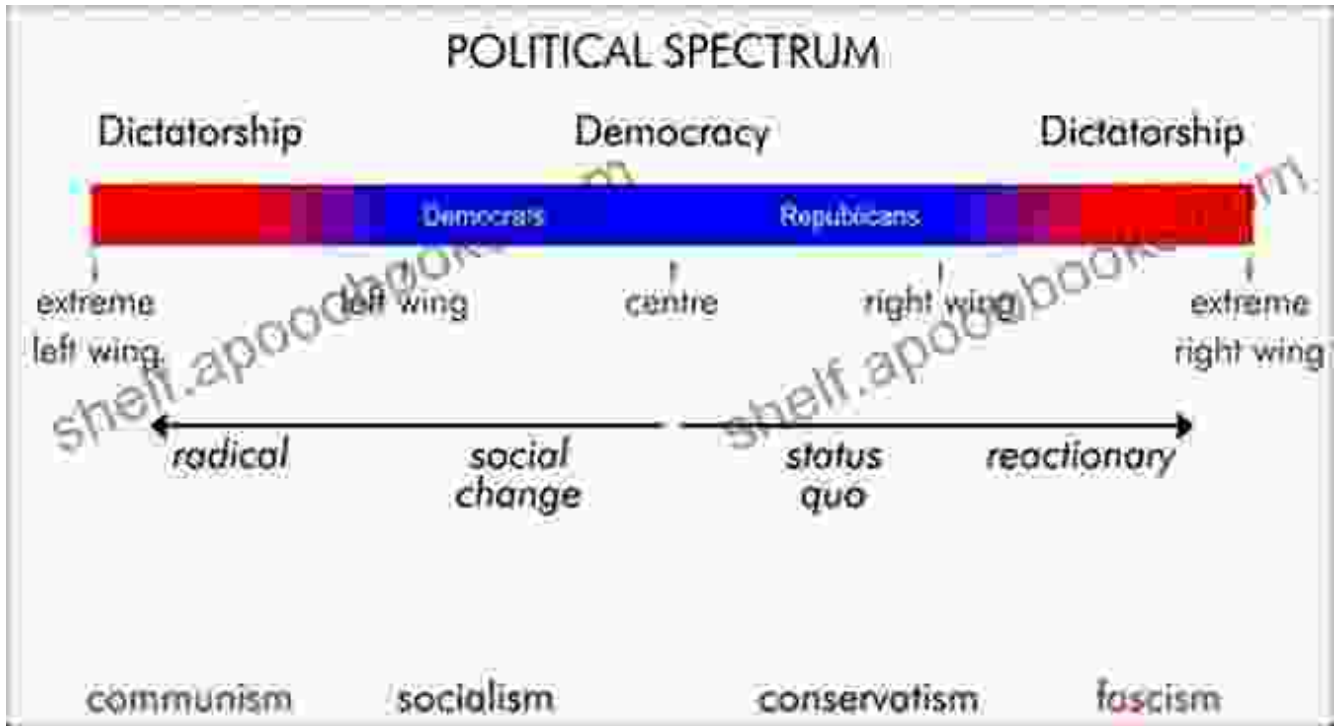

- Using multiple sources will help you get accurate info and avoid propaganda

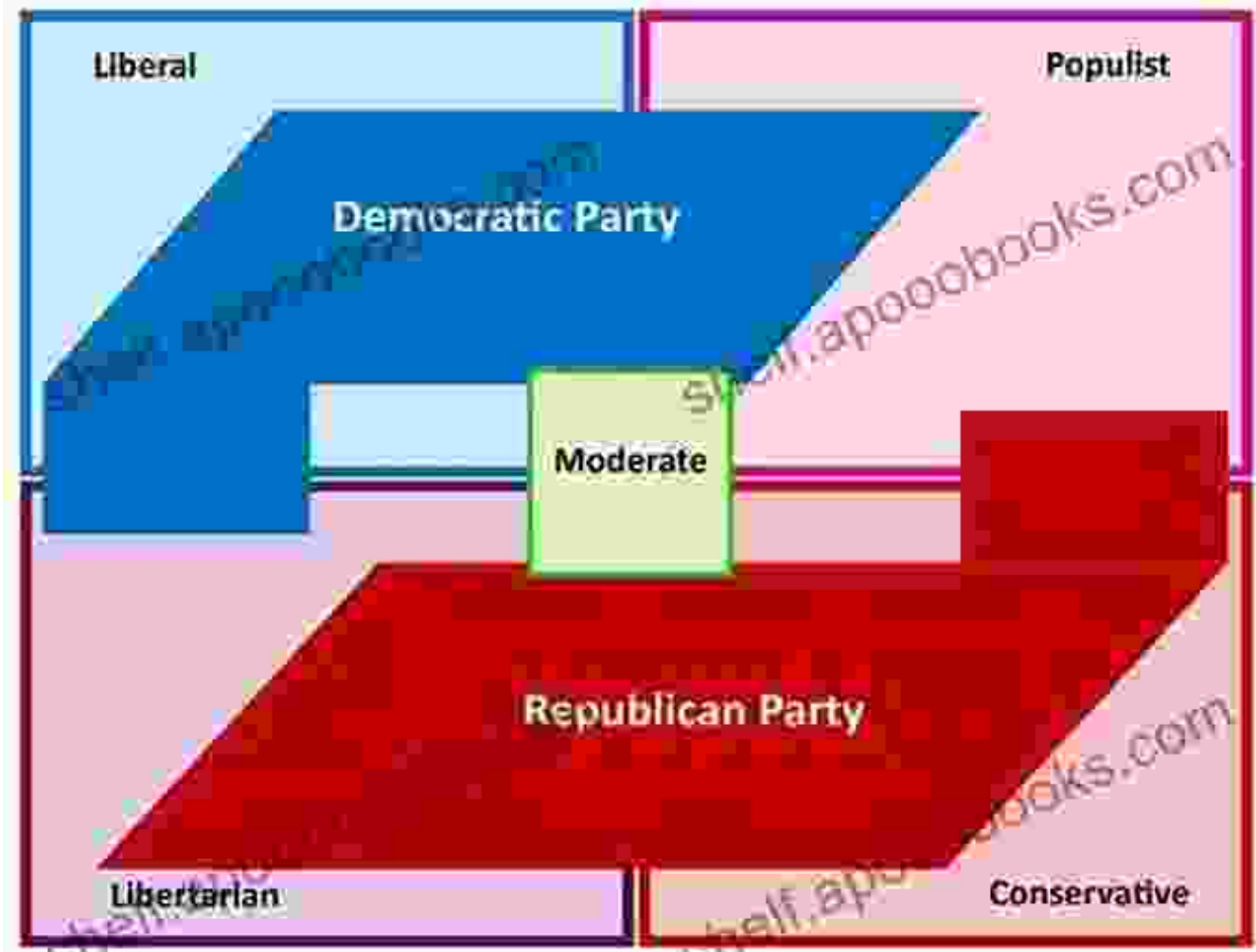
